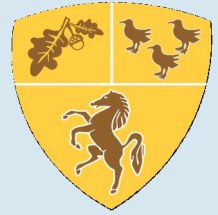

Road Closure

TYLER HILL ROAD, BLEAN (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Tyler Hill Road, Blean, near Canterbury.

A closure is planned from Monday 23rd April 2018 with estimated completion by 27th April 2018.

Tyler Hill Road will be closed between the junction with Tyler Hill Road spur road (east of the junction with A290 Blean Common) and School Lane.

The alternative route is via Tyler Hill Spur Road, Clock Tower Parade and School Lane.

Access to The Green will be maintained as signposted on site.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
